SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING
May 12, 2008

Mayor Rorie called the Special City Council meeting to discuss Rural Water Association rate increase and Water Bond Resolution passed Thursday May 8, 2008.

Recorder Treasurer called the roll: Aldermen Randy Churches, Don Crow, L.J. Davis, and Dickey Hink answered present. Kip Stringer arrived at 12:05 p.m. PRESENT (5)

Others present were Zeke Keeling, Donna George, Joe Marshall, and Van Buren County Democrat.

The first item of business was Water Bond. There was much discussion ending with two decisions made.

1. Special meeting scheduled for May 15, 2008 in City Hall at 7:00 p.m. and have Jim Alexander present to discuss savings with Council.
2. Vote to repeal resolution passed at City Council meeting May 8, 2008.

Alderman Churches made motion seconded by Alderman Davis to repeal Resolution 2008-06. Roll Call: Churches, Crow, Davis, Hink, and Stringer voted yes. Motion Passed (5)

The second item of business was rural water rate increase. There was much discussion ending with a vote for increase.

Alderman Crow made motion seconded by Alderman Davis to increase rural water rates by five percent (5%) effective on their next bill and five percent (5%) for five (5) years. Roll Call: Aldermen Crow, Davis, Hink, and Stringer voted yes.
